

WHAT ARE JUSSI SCANDINAVIAN BEDS?

Founded in Sweden in 1949, Jussi [YOU-see] Scandinavian Beds distributes luxury mattresses to fine retailers and high-end hotels in 13 countries around the world.

Honoring traditional methods, every Jussi Bed is **completely handcrafted by a single highly-trained artisan** in the European Union. This allows for meticulous attention to detail and strict quality control.

Sustainable, natural and chemical-free materials, such as Icelandic wool, cotton, Talalay Latex and flax, ensure that the beds are healthy for people, as well as the environment. The coils inside each bed are constructed of piano wire grade Swedish Sandvik steel to provide durable, lasting support. Swedish pine harvested from sustainable forests is used to construct the sturdy bottom frame.



WHAT MAKES JUSSI BEDS DIFFERENT?

Unlike mattresses here in the States, each Jussi bed is constructed in three separate pieces that stack one on top of the other.

TOP LAYER

The **top layer** offers comfort with a latex core for pressure relief. One side of this layer has a cool cotton cover, while the opposite side has a cozy wool cover, offering hypoallergenic and temperature-regulating benefits, so your bedding can adapt as the seasons change.

MIDDLE LAYER

The **middle layer** provides support based on your needs and sleep habits. (Do you like your mattresses firm, or a little softer? Do you sleep on your back or stomach?) The wrapped coils inside individually adapt and react to your body weight, and combine with a layer of latex or toxin-free foam for a cradled, weightless feeling.

BOTTOM LAYER

The **bottom layer** supplies additional support and a sturdy foundation. Individually wrapped heavy-gauge springs work to eliminate motion transfer between partners, while also relieving pressure in achy areas of the body to reduce tossing and turning throughout the night. A built-in hardwood frame equips the whole sleep system with a strong, stable base.
